Dear Ms. Melanie Roberts-Boyd,

All of us at Houston Neuropsychology Associates appreciate the opportunity to participate in the care of your patients. Presently, we realize that our wait time for appointments has grown beyond our typical and historical norms. We understand that long wait time is frustrating not only to patients and their family members, but also to you and your staff.

While we work to recruit additional neuropsychology providers for our group, we have implemented a priority system for appointments to help route patients to the soonest available appointments. All patients are important to us and all referrals are appreciated, but not all requests that we receive represent equally urgent or pressing needs for evaluation. We also understand that there may be factors beyond those easily discernible from medical records that may contribute to the referral (e.g., family is insisting on it).

We are now screening referrals to identify cases that seem to be less urgent or may not be ideal candidates for neuropsychological evaluation. We have identified this referral as one of those cases. Two of our clinical neuropsychologists reviewed the available records and made the following notes:

Records indicate that despite the use of a Spanish-speaking interpreter, the patient was unable to complete a brief cognitive screening measure (MMSE). Records also indicate that she has been diagnosed with moderate Alzheimer's disease with frequent hallucinations and that her husband is the only person she recognizes. These factors suggest that she has diffuse cognitive impairments and would be very unlikely to perform more extensive diagnostic testing. Thus, further testing would appear unlikely to yield additional beneficial information.

Should you have additional information to provide or want us to reconsider, we will happily do so. Otherwise, we thank you for the referral but will preserve our appointment slots for cases with greater urgency.

It is our sincere hope that this triage system will eventually lead to reduced wait time for appointments while we pursue other solutions. Your feedback is always welcome. Should you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact us directly.
